2010 Mapleton Market Community Produce Tent Guidelines

Mapleton Market is a sub-committee of the MADCA (Mapleton and District Community Association Inc.). This community run event is held four times per year to celebrate the start of each new season. The objectives are to showcase and develop our community, businesses, talents, products, produce and services. When we reach \$5,000 funds will be distributed to Mapleton community groups via a public application process.

Stall sites are limited therefore it is **essential to pre book**. This application form can be downloaded from www.mapletonmarket.net.au or you can contact Tania Hubbard (5441 3510 (after 2.30pm weekdays) if you need it posted.

- Application Form** Local backyard growers who wish to access the Community Produce Tent Facility must fill out this application form. This is not for commercial producers.
- What's the cost?** A position in the Community Produce Tent is \$5 and allows you to *sell* your surplus home grown fruit and vegetables. Please pay on market day. Receipts will be issued for all payments. (If you wish, a full site, where available, can be purchased for \$15 for 3m x 3m - fill out Stall Holder's application).
- Is a tent provided?** We will provide the tent. You must provide a small table and chairs as required. You are only allowed one table space.
- Can I just turn up?** If you have not booked you may have the opportunity to participate if space is available. This is at the discretion of the committee.
- Cleaning up** Please clear up your area at closure of the market, and take all your rubbish with you!
- Stall holders must not damage the market site or release liquids or other wastes which would damage the environment. (see Council Guidelines).
- Market Hours & Set-up** Stallholders are required to be set up before 7:30am and remain setup until 12:30pm (2:30pm in August). **Market trading hours**, set up and pack up times are to be **strictly adhered to**. (See Council Regulations).
- No Vehicles on site!** No vehicles are allowed on the grassed area of the Lily Ponds as per Sunshine Coast Regional Council market approval rules.
- Vehicle access** to Fish Tales car park is restricted to before 7:30am and after 12:30pm (2:30pm in August).
- Where do I park?** We request **all** stall holders & groups to park in the Mapleton Hall and Sports Grounds once unloaded. Parking in the Bowls Club or Hotel car parks is not permitted. Our aim is for you to have a successful market. If you park behind the shops or in the streets close to the market your customers may not stop! Please help us to help you by obliging.
